## Qualified for Qualification Phase 2:

After the matches for the Men's EHF EURO 2014 Qualification Phase 2 will have been finalized (in June 2013) the three lowest ranked $4^{\text {th }}$ places of all 7 groups will play against the three winners of the EHF EURO 2016 Qualification Phase 1 two play-off matches (2 / 3 April and 5 / 6 April 2014). The winners of these play-off matches will join the other already qualified participants to the EURO 2016 Qualification Phase 2.

## Qualification Phase 1:

The 9 registered teams for the EHF EURO 2016 Qualification Phase 1 are (in alphabetical order): BEL, CYP, EST, FIN, GBR, GRE, IRL, ITA, LUX.
Phase 1 will be played in 3 groups of 3 teams. The winners of each group will play the play off matches as above mentioned.

The 9 teams are seeded based on the EHF National Team Ranking valid for the EHF EURO 2016 Qualification (including the results of the EHF EURO 2014 Qualification Phase 1 and the results of the 2013 WCh ESP Qualification Europe Phase 1):
