Foreword

Dear Handball Friends,



For the eighth consecutive year, the European Handball Federation returns to Sweden and in particular, the city of Gothenburg for the fourth edition of the Women's 18 European Open. In the first week of summer, we welcome you to Scandinavia, home of the largest youth handball festival.

This event is the first national team event to throw-off the EHF summer programme. From the 2 – 6 July, the competition will present fourteen teams, born generation 1994 or later, who have travelled across Europe to be part of this handball spectacle. Over the next five days, the teams will play 43 matches in the hopes of becoming the next team to win the Women's 18 European Open. At the last event in 2010, the national team of Denmark took the title after taking on the national team of Russia; Sweden ranked third. In 2012, the Danes will not be back to defend their title, so this event promises a new champion.

The teams have been drawn into four groups and the first matches will play out in Hall A of the Valhalla sport complex, which holds 700 spectators and the Liseberg Hall, where a 2000-strong crowd is expected. All matches to determine places 1-8 beginning on 6 July, will be played in front of a capacity crowd of 6,000 in the Scandinavium Arena.

Once again, the Swedish club handball team of IK Sävehof and the Svenska Handbollförbundet have joined forces to bring this Younger Age Category (YAC) event back to Gothenburg. The EHF YAC events remain the best platform to highlight the development of the young up-and-coming players and it provides a stage for the trainees from the Young Referee Programme. Therefore, on behalf of the European Handball Federation, I take this opportunity to thank these two organisations for their diligent efforts that have culminated in yet another outstanding event.



Finally, I wish you a pleasant stay in Gothenburg; support your teams with passion, enjoy the matches and may the best team win!

Preliminary round

The EHF 8th European Open Tournament for NATIONAL TEAMS in Gothenburg will be played in **four** groups. In the preliminary round of this tournament each team will play against the others within the groups.

- The final ranking in each group after the preliminary round is the ranking basis for the Main Round and Challenge Round.
- The duration of each match will be two times **25 minutes** (five minutes half time break) for the preliminary round.
- During the preliminary round *only team time outs will be granted*.
- In case of a 7 meter throw decision the playing time continues.

After the completion of the preliminary round, *each team will play against the others, within the respective pools, starting with 0 points*, in both **Main Round** and **Challenge Round** as well.

The teams will form the final pools, bringing together:

- The teams ranked **1st** and **2nd** in each **PR** group – **Main Round (MR)**
- The teams ranked **3rd** and **respectively 4th** (Gr. C + D) in each **PR** group – **Challenge Round (CR)**
- **Four pools** will be formed.
- It will be played accordingly for places:
 - **Main Round Pools I + II:** **1 - 8**
 - **Challenge Round Pools III + IV:** **9 - 14**
- The duration of each match will be two times **25 minutes**.
 - Five minutes half time break.
 - Team time outs will be granted.
 - In case of a 7 meter throw decision the playing time continues.

Points are awarded as follows:

Playing Rules

The EHF W18 European Open Championship will be played according to the 'Rules of the Game' valid from July 1st 2010.

Procedure of the 'shoot-out' competition

'Shoot-out' Rules and procedures

Five players (these players do not have to be pre-nominated prior to the shoot-out phase) who are eligible to play take throws alternating with the opposite team (a goalkeeper can also be a thrower). If the number of players drops below 5 in one round by punishments of the referees, the team in question will have correspondingly fewer opportunities.

The winner is the team that has scored more goals after 5 throws.

If the outcome has not been decided after the first round, the "shoot-out" is continued. For this purpose, the ends shall be changed and then the other team goes first. Again 5 players ...etc. In the second round and any subsequent rounds the match is decided as soon as one team takes the lead once, there have been an equal number of attempts by each team.

In the "shoot-out" the referees use a toss to determine the choice of ends and which team starts. If a team has won the toss and elects to start in the "shoot-out", then the opponents have the right to choose the end. Alternatively, if the team that wins the toss prefers to choose ends, then the opponents ...

The passing (attacking) goalkeeper starts off standing on the goal line at least with one foot. The court player with the ball must stand in the playing area with one foot on the 9 metre-line (The player decides where).

When the referee whistles the player plays back the ball to the goalkeeper on the goal line. During the pass or the catch of the goalkeeper, the ball is not allowed to touch the ground. Once the ball has left the player's hand, the defending goalkeeper may move forward, however both goalkeepers must remain in their goal area. The attacking goalkeeper must pass the ball to her teammate, who is running towards the opponent's goal. Also during this pass or the catch of the attacking player, the ball is not allowed to touch the ground.

The attacking player must catch the ball and try to score a goal without dribbling or any other rule violation. If the attacking goalkeeper or the court player commits a rule violation, the attack is over.

In case of the defending goalkeeper committing a rule violation by leaving her goal area during a shoot-out attempt of an attacking player, the following rule specification concerning "progressive punishment" shall apply:

1) defending goalkeeper not touching the attacking player:

1.1. in case of a regular goal scored by the attacker - goal decision and warning (yellow card) for the defending goalkeeper

1.2. in case of no goal scored by the attacker - 7m penalty for the attacking team and warning (yellow card) for the defending goalkeeper

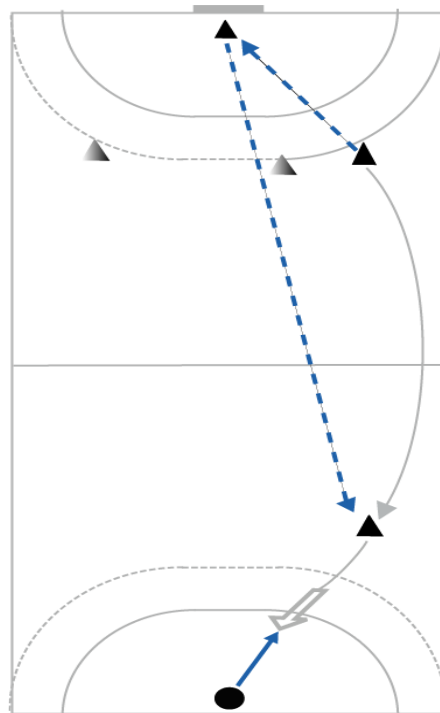
1.3. any repeated leaving of the goal area by the defending goalkeeper during a shoot-out attempt by the attacking player shall be penalized by disqualification (red card)
(any player eligible to play can replace the goalkeeper in that case)

2) defending goalkeeper touching the attacking player

2.1. in case of a regular goal scored by the attacker - goal decision and disqualification (red card) for the defending goalkeeper

2.2. in case of no goal scored by the attacker - 7m penalty for the attacking team and disqualification (red card) for the defending goalkeeper (any player eligible to play can replace the goalkeeper in that case).

*) At younger age category events the Tournament Management may decide that the attacking goalkeeper is allowed to pass the ball from within the 9m zone instead of from within the 6m goal area.
