2008 Men's 20 ECh Qualification – 21 to 23 March 2008

(Players born 1988 and younger)

Total number of entries: 35 (including ROU, CRO, DEN) **Qualified for the Final Tournament:**

ROU (organiser), **CRO** (1st of 2006 M18 ECh), **DEN** (2nd of 2006 M18 ECh) **Qualification is played with:** 8 groups of 4 teams

\Rightarrow 13 teams will qualify for the final tournament in ROU from the qualification groups.

Group 1-5: 2 teams will qualify out of each of these five groups Group 6-8: 1 team will qualify out of each of these three groups

(Players born 1988 and younger)

Entries: 32 (including MKD, DEN, ESP) **Qualified for the Final Tournament:**

MKD (organiser), DEN (1st of 2007 W19 ECh), ESP (2nd of 2007 W19 ECh) Qualification: 1 group of 5 teams, 6 groups of 4 teams

\Rightarrow Europe has 10 places available in FYR Macedonia, incl. MKD as organiser; therefore 7 European teams will qualify for the final tournament in MKD.

Group 1-7: 1 team will qualify out of each group
