EHF Challenge Trophy



The 2008 edition of the Women's Challenge Trophy is currently taking place in Larnaca, Cyprus. This event was established in 1999 and is aimed at the developing handball nations of Europe. This is the 5th edition of the women's competition. The eight nations taking part in this event are: Bosnia and Herzegovina, Cyprus, Estonia, Faroe Islands, Finland, Great Britain, Israel and Malta. The finals and placement matches will take place on 30 March.

EHF EURO 2010 Draw and EHF Competitions Conference



The weekend of 18 – 20 April will see handball specialists, focusing on the men's discipline of the sport, converging on Vienna. On 18 April 2008, the draw for the EHF EURO 2010 Qualifications will take place in the form of a gala evening. This will be followed by the EHF Competitions Conference for Men's Handball on Saturday 28 March. The event, coming under the motto "Benchmarking Men's Handball", will be an open discussion platform with

the objective of defining a common strategy for the future of men's handball. The deadline to register for this event is Tuesday 1 April at the EHF Headquarters.

The times of the EHF Men's Champions League Semi-finals have now been finalised, with both matches of the first leg taking place on 6 April 2008.
