EHF and EHF Marketing GmbH Structural Changes



The Lillehammer EHF Extraordinary Congress voted to make changes to the structure of the EHF and its marketing arm EHF Marketing GmbH.

This alignment in the structure of the EHF and its marketing arm, EHF Marketing GmbH, secures a platform for all stakeholders enabling permanent dialogue in decisive matters.

Elections

The process of installing the new EHF bodies began immediately after the EHF Extraordinary Congress. The elections took place after the EHF Competitions Conference.

EHF Competitions Committees

The three EHF Competitions Committees consult with the Competitions Commission and are installed within the structure of the EHF: Men's European Club Handball, Women's European Club Handball and National Teams Competitions with 5 members, with the chairman of each Committee positioned also within the Competitions Commission.
