## EHF EURO 2008 in FYR Macedonia DRAW FINAL TOURNAMENT – PREVIEW

The 8<sup>th</sup> Women's European Championship Final Tournament will take place from **2 December to 14 December 2008**.

After the completion of the play-off matches for the Women's EHF EURO 2008, we are now nearing the final tournament draw in FYR Macedonia which will take place this coming Sunday.

The EHF EURO 2008 Preliminary Round Groups will be drawn on Sunday, 20 July 2008, 20:00 hrs. in the Ancient Amphitheatre in Ohrid on the eve of the 2008 Women's U20 World Championship. The following day on Monday 21 July at 11.00hrs. an official Women's EHF Euro 2008 Press Conference will take place.

Altogether 16 teams divided into four pots qualified from the past European Championship and the play-off matches which took place in early June for the Women's EHF EURO 2008 in FYR Macedonia.



Along with all three reigning champions:

European Champion: Norway World Champion: Russia Olympic Champion: Denmark

Portugal made its way through to a European Championship Final Tournament for the first time in Euro Events history.

The Women's EHF EURO 2008 Preliminary Round and Main Round Groups will be played in Skopje and Ohrid.

The assignment of the four groups to the two venues will take place after the draw and will be announced during the Women's EHF EURO 2008 Press Conference on Monday 21 July at 11.00hrs.

The draw event will be transmitted live by both MKRTV from FYR Macedonia and PROTV from Romania. The Women's EHF EURO 2008 website has now been launched and will be transmitted live from the Ancient Amphitheatre in Ohrid.
