

The region: Macedonia



The geographic and historical region of Greece in the southern Balkans, the largest and second most populous Greek region, dominated by mountains in the interior and the port cities of Thessaloniki and Kavala on its southern coastline. Macedonia is part of Northern Greece.

It incorporates most of the territories of ancient Macedonia, a kingdom whose most celebrated members were Alexander the Great and his father Philip II.

Thessaloniki is the second-largest city in Greece and the capital of the region of Macedonia. Lies on the northern fringe of the Thermaic Gulf. Its proximity to imposing mountain ranges, hills and fault lines, especially towards its southeast have historically made the city prone to geological changes. In 2015 reached a total of 1,500,000 inhabitants.

Thessaloniki is a major economic, industrial, commercial and political center of Greece and a major transportation hub for the rest of southeastern Europe.



The city has always been known between Greeks for its vibrant city culture, including having the most waterfront cafe's and bars per-capita than any other city in Europe and culinary tastes; and as having some of the best nightlife and entertainment in the country, thanks to its large young population and multicultural feel.

Recently Lonely Planet listed Thessaloniki as the world's fifth-best "ultimate party city".


The Avant Garde Sports Club is located at the village of Kardia (altitude: 81- 127m, coordinates: 40°29'01.35"N 22°59'17.26"E,

http://maps.google.com/maps?hl=el&ll=40.484078,22.98755 &spn=0.004578,0.010568&t=h&z=17&vpsrc=6), about 20km southeast of Thessaloniki.

A private multiplex built on a hillside in an area of 80 acres, surrounded by 3,500 trees, overlooking Thessaloniki and the Thermaic Gulf. The complex features sporting facilities, restaurants, congress/social events hall, children playground, leisure facilities and swimming pools, folk art museum, and a church. It has a parking capacity of up to 400 cars.



 - Center court: 300 seats
 - Secondary court: 200 seats
- A large electronic scoreboard is available on each one of the courts
- Both courts feature permanent floodlight (800 lux) installations permitting night competition and very good quality night match internet live streaming transmission

Situated next to the sea, the climate is directly affected by it. Thessaloniki has a humid subtropical climate that borders on a semi-arid climate with annual average precipitation of 450 mm due to the Prokletije rain shadow drying the westerly winds. The city lies in a transitional climatic zone, so its climate displays characteristics of continental and Mediterranean climates.

Thessaloniki averages on weather in month May:




Arrival airport "Makedonia" (SKG)
