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* **Minimun requirements**

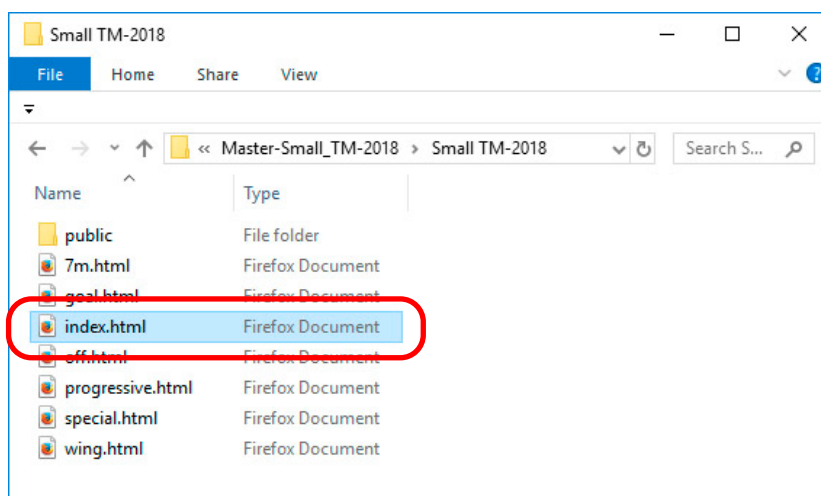
In order to work properly, the following minimun requirements must be met:

- 1 GB RAM
- 1024x768 minimun screen resolution, 32 bits color depth
- Windows XP or newer (Windows version)
- MAC OS X 10.5.8 or newer

The Interface is **responsive web design** which makes web pages render well on a variety of devices and window or screen sizes, so you can open with a different devices, such as the display of a desktop computer, tablet PC and a smartphone.

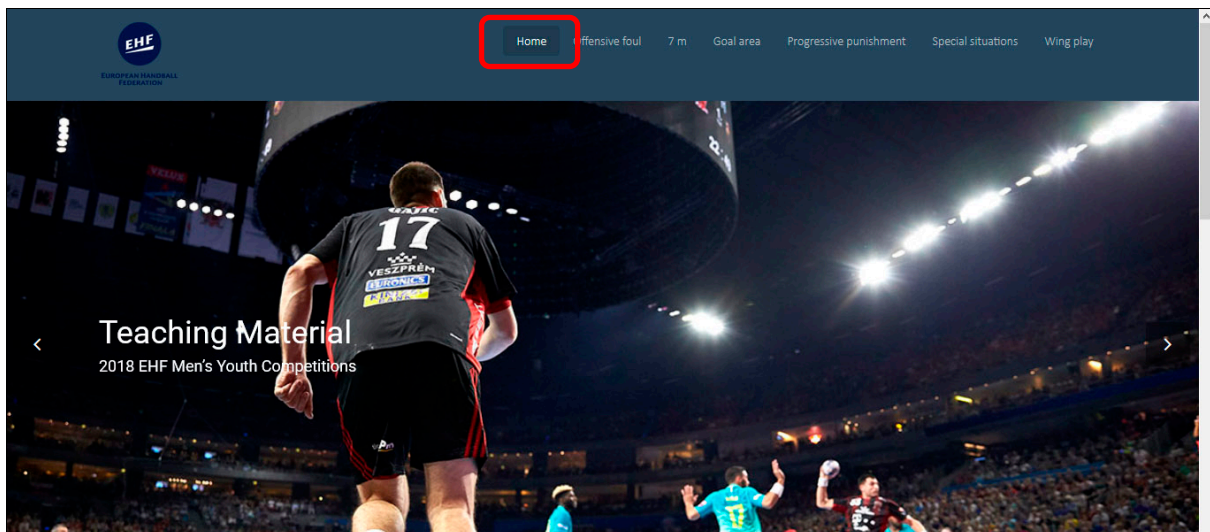

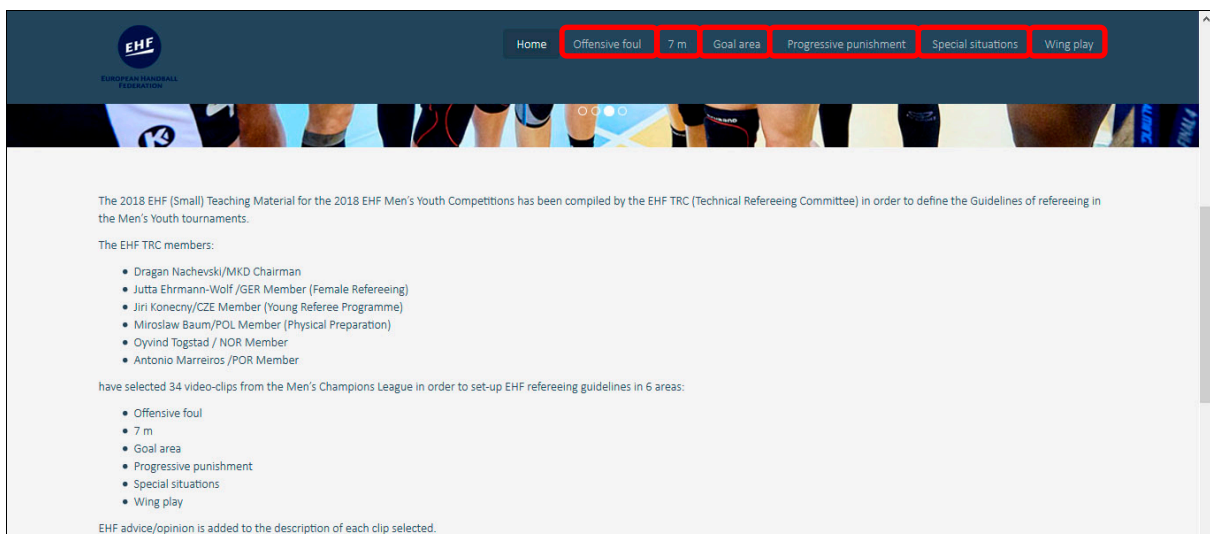
We recommend using Google Chrome, Mozilla Firefox or Safari Web browsers.

* INTERFACE

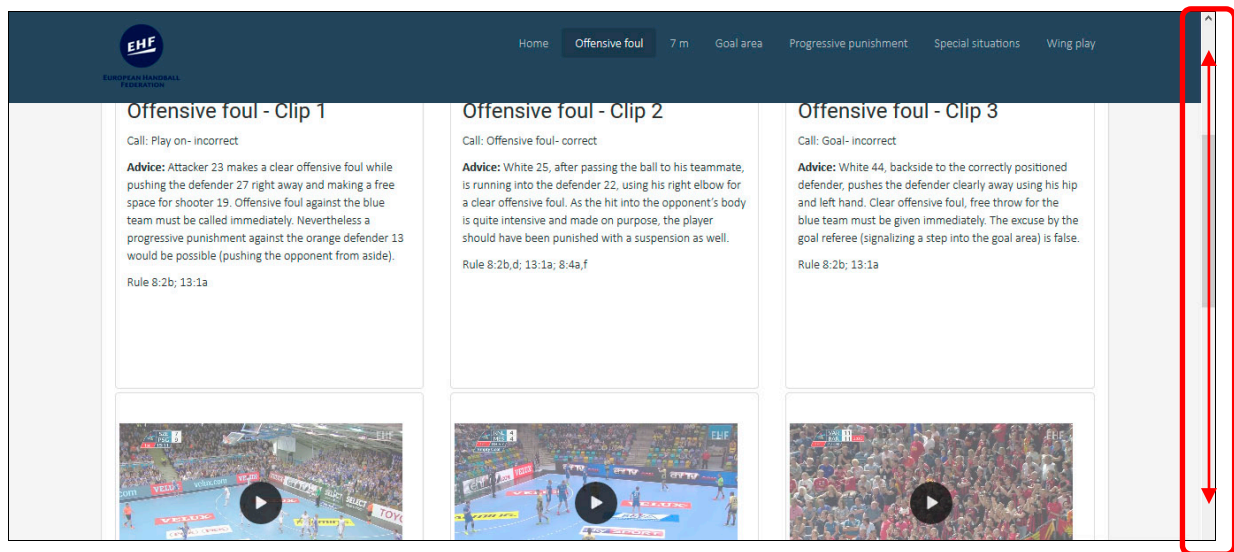
1. **Main/Category Page.** Click on the “HOME” button to go to the main Page.



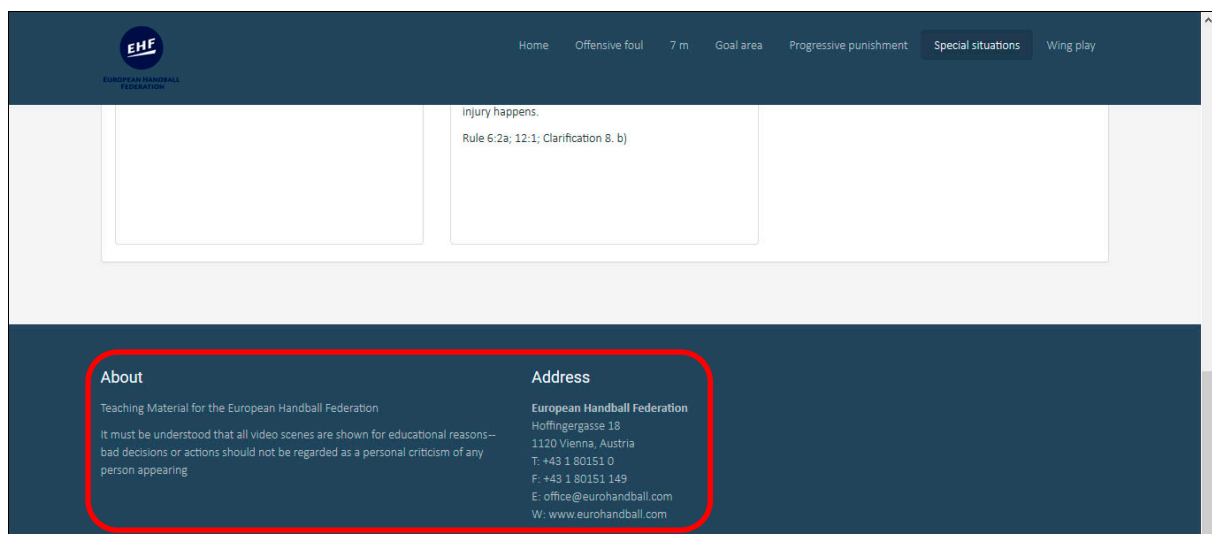
2. **Main/Category Page.** Click on the “Category” button to go to the Video page.




3. **All Page.** Move up and/or down to show all information. You may use the mouse wheel up and/or down to scroll through the page.



4. **All Page.** At the end of each page you have corresponding information.



5. **Video Page.** Move up and/or down and Click on the video you wish to watch.
Doble click on the video to show full screen.



6. **Video Page.** Below each video you will see the corresponding text.

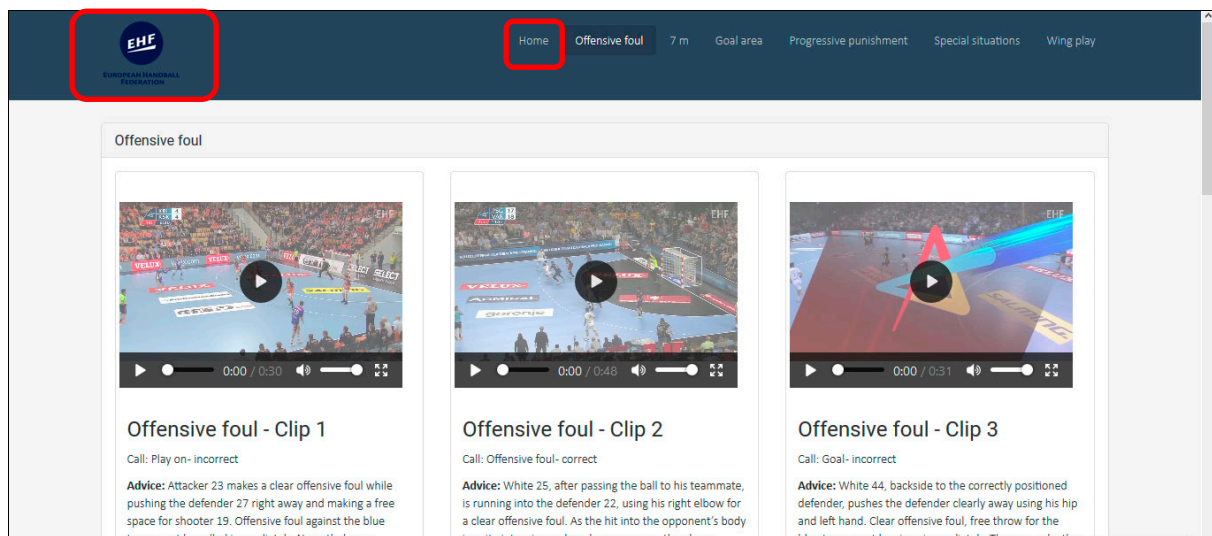

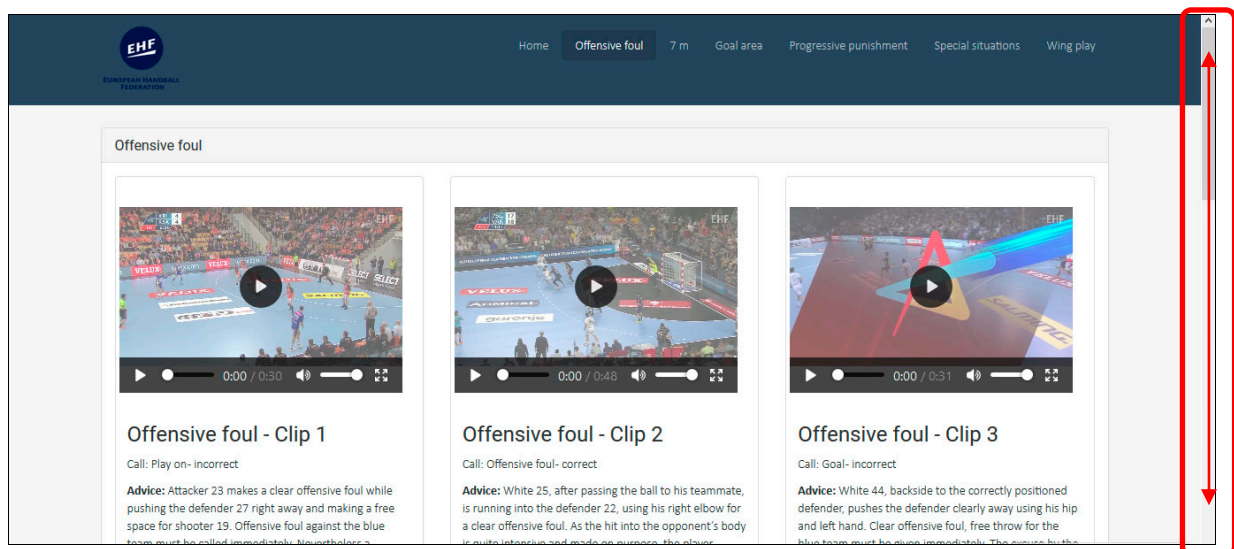
- Goal area - Clip 1**
Call: Goal – incorrect
Advice: The attacker (pivot) is clearly landing in the goal area before shooting. A goalkeeper throw must be called.
Rule 6:1, 6:2a, 12:1
- Goal area - Clip 2**
Call: 7m – incorrect
Advice: The attacker (pivot) clearly touches the goal area line with one foot before getting the ball and even after. A goalkeeper throw must be called.
Rule 6:1, 6:2a, 12:1
- Goal area - Clip 3**
Call: Goal – incorrect
Advice: The attacker (pivot) is clearly landing in the goal area before shooting. A goalkeeper throw must be called.
Rule 6:1, 6:2a, 12:1

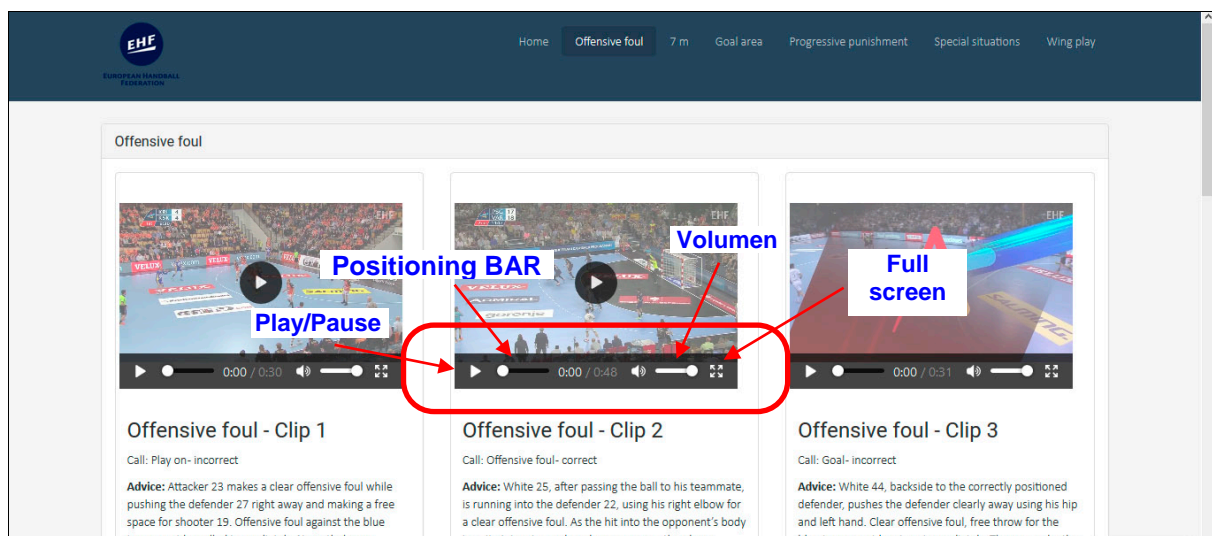
7. **All Page.** Click on the “HOME” button or “EHF logo” to go to the main Page.



8. **Video page.** To select another video move up and/or down, and Click on the video you wish to watch. **Doble click on the video or full screen button to show full screen.**

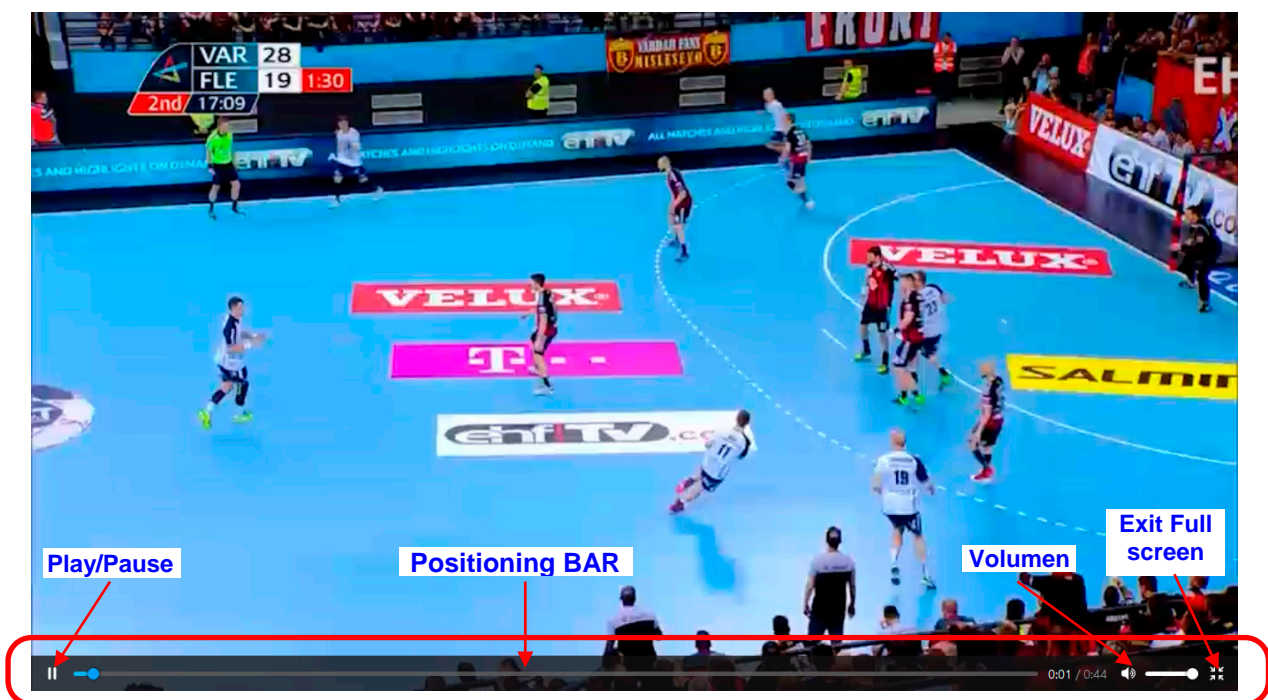


9. **Video buttons.** Click on video buttons to control the video. These buttons may vary depending on the browser used (Here you see them with Mozilla Firefox).



10. **Full screen.** To exit full screen:

- Double click on left mouse button,

It is possible to control certain aspects of the user interface via keyboard, as follows:

- **Spacebar:** play/pause video
- **Right cursor:** step forward during video
- **Left cursor:** step backwards during video
